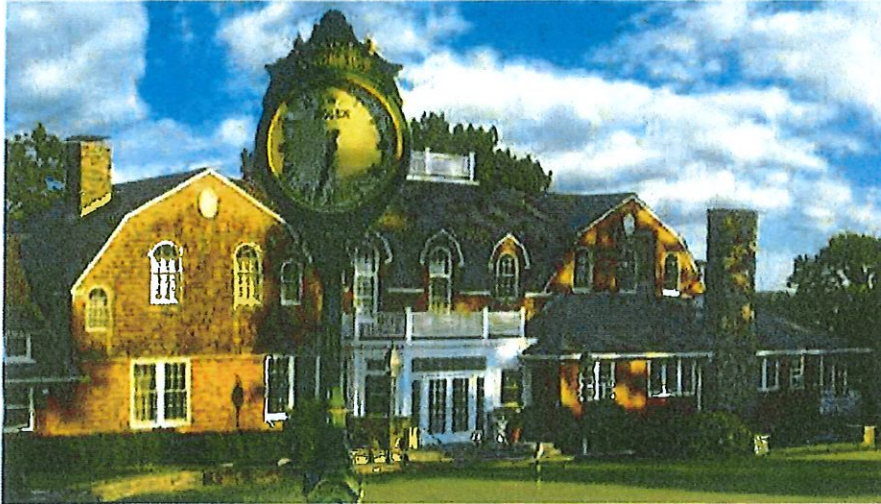

RECIPROCAL CLUB INFORMATION

Ardley S&TC (limited to 5 rds)

- **Ardley S&TC Members** are limited to 5 rounds of golf per year.
- **Ardley S&TC Members** are permitted to bring up to 10 guests per season, in addition to their 5 allotted rounds.
- Subject to availability, **full access** to our golf course on **Tuesdays** and **Thursdays**
- **Limited access (after 12:00 p.m.)** to our golf course on **Wednesday, Fridays, Saturdays, Sundays & Holidays.**
- May invite guests any day of the week.
- Reciprocal access to Saint Andrew's Practice facilities will follow the guidelines above. Each reciprocal member will be charged **\$30** for the unlimited daily use of the range, putting green, and chipping facilities.
- Opportunity to host mini-outings (member + 11 guests) or full outings
- Arrangements to play must be made with the Club Professional, Mr. Gregory Bisconti, PGA via email at gbisconti@saintandrewsgolfclub.com. Mr. Bisconti, or his staff, will provide the players with caddies, carts and local instructions. Saint Andrew's is a challenging course, and it is assumed that The AS&TC members will be reasonably proficient at the game and fully conversant with all rules of etiquette and dress code
- Full access to our locker room, pro shop, teaching facilities and driving range on the above-mentioned days
- Full access to our John Reid Room and formal dining facilities
- **Greens Fees**
 - Tues-Thur - \$125pp
 - Fri-Sun - \$150pp
- **Cart Fees**
 - \$40pp
- **Forecaddie (required)**
 - Suggested fee is \$60pp
